## Study 2: What Is a Local Church?

- **A. No Formal Definition:** The New Testament gives no real definition, but we can describe what a church ought to be like from the examples there.
- **B.** Working Definition: "A local church is an assembly of professing believers in Christ who have been baptized and who are organized to do God's will." (Charles C. Ryrie, *A Survey of Bible Doctrine*, p. 141.)

  - 2. who have been **baptized**:

  - 3. who are **organized**:

  - 4. to do God's will: This would include
    - a. Observance of the ordinances (communion, baptism)
    - b. Fulfilling the Great Commission in all parts of the world (Matt. 28:18-20; Acts 1:8).
