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<sup>1</sup> 4:1 baby ([3516](#) *nepios*): lit., "not speaking" - a baby that does not yet speak.

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  - D3 peace: Finding contentment in one's relationship with God and His ability to take care for you.
  - D4 patience: The capacity to endure injustice; being long-fused
  - D5 kindness: The exercise of goodness and well-being toward others.
  - D6 goodness: The capacity of being morally good in character and demeanor, taking a delight in that which is excellent and honorable.
