2. Joseph runs the Egyptian “Grain Sale” during the famine. Gen. 47:13-26
3. Jacob blesses Joseph’s two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh. Gen. 48:1-22
4. Jacob gives a prophetic blessing to his twelve sons. Gen. 49:1-28
5. Jacob’s death and burial back in the land of Canaan. Gen. 49:29 - 50:14
6. Joseph assures his brothers of forgiveness and protection. Gen. 50:15-21
7. Joseph dies and requests burial in Canaan when the nation returns there from Egypt. Gen. 50:22-26
