Bible Study #4 Ephesians 5:22-33

- A. Instructions for Wives. Ephesians 5:22-24. Ephesians is the name of a letter that an important leader in the early church named Paul wrote. He wrote this letter to Christians in the city of Ephesus (in modern day Turkey). What Paul wrote was exactly what God wanted those Christians (and all Christians of all ages) to hear and obey.
