- 1. Genesis 1:1. In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
- 2. Joshua 1:8. Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
- 3. Psalm 23:1-6. (1) The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want. (2) He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside quiet waters, (3) He restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for His name's sake. (4) Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. (5) You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. (6) Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.
- 4. Psalm 119:9. How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to Your word.
- 5. Psalm 119:11. I have hidden Your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.
- 6. Proverbs 9:10. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.
- 7. Isaiah 53:6. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.
- 8. The Lord's Prayer (Matt. 6:9-13). (9) ... "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name, (10) Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (11) Give us today our daily bread. (12) Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. (13) And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.
- 9. Mark 10:43-45. (43) Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, (44) and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. (45) For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.
- 10. John 1:1-3. (1) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (2) He was with God in the beginning. (3) Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made.

- 11. John 1:11-12. (11) He came to that which was His own, but His own did not receive Him. (12) Yet to all who received Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God.
- 12. John 3:16-18. (16) For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. (17) For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the word, but to save the world through Him. (18) Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.
- 13. John 5:24. I tell you the truth, whoever hears My word and believes Him who sent Me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life.
- 14. John 10:27-29. (27) My sheep listen to My voice; I know them, and they follow me. (28) I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of My hand. (29) My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of My Father's hand.
- 15. John 14:6. Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."
- 16. Acts 4:12. Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.
- 17. Romans 3:23. For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
- 18. Romans 5:8. But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- 19. Romans 6:23. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 20. Romans 8:1. Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
- 21. Romans 8:28. And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to His purpose.
- 22. 1 Corinthians 15:3-6. (3) For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, (4) that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, (5) and that He appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve. (6) After that, He appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.

- 23. Ephesians 4:29-32. (29) Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. (30) And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. (31) Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. (32) Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
- 24. Philippians 1:6. Being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
- 25. Philippians 4:4. Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
- 26. Philippians 4:6-7. (6) Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. (7) And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
- 27. 2 Timothy 3:15-17. (15) and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. (16) All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, (17) so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- 28. 1 John 1:9. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
- 29. 1 John 5:11-13. (11) And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. (12) He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. (13) I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.
- 30. Revelation 3:20. (Jesus speaking) "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with Me."
