1. I must admit my sin.

- a. "All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way" Isaiah 53:6a
- b. "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23.

2. I must acknowledge that what I earn through my sin is death.

- a. "Behold, all souls are Mine; the soul of the father as well as the soul of the son is Mine. The soul who sins will die. Ezekiel 18:4.
- b. "For the wages of sin is death" Romans 6:23a.

3. I must understand that Yahweh, God, loves me so much He sent Jesus to die for my sin in my place.

- a. "But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed." Isaiah 53:5
- b. "But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him." Isaiah 53:6b
- c. "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

4. If I trust in Jesus, I can be reconciled with God, be completely forgiven, and escape coming judgment!

- a. (Isa 53:11-12 NNAS) As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see *it* and be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, As He will bear their iniquities." Isaiah 53:11.
- b. "Come now, and let us reason together," Says the LORD, "Though your sins are as scarlet, They will be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They will be like wool. Isaiah 1:18.
- c. "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life." John 3:16.
- d. "He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God." John 3:18.
