<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Isa. 6:2 - seraphim: This is the plural of *saraph* (saw-rawf') (<u>8314</u>). This refers (1) to fiery serpents (Num. 21:6, 8; Deut. 8:15); to flying serpents (Isa. 14:29; 30:6); together these seem to be like dragons; (2) to (presumably) fiery angelic beings possessing six wings, of a high order of intelligence worshiping God and proclaiming his holiness and global glory (Isa. 6:2, 6).
