What Do We Learn About Angels from Genesis 18:1-19:29?

Introduction: The Hebrew word malak (4397) means "messenger." One has to determine from the context whether the messenger is merely a human messenger or if it is a supernatural messenger sent from God. This account reveals what two particular messengers looked like and what supernatural powers they possessed. It is a very revealing incident from a Biblical historical narrative.
