**Conclusion:** A temptation (*peirasmos*, <u>3986</u>), in general, is a hardship or an opportunity to do evil, either one of which might attract a person away from doing the will of God. We know from related Scripture that God never solicits anyone to do evil (James 1:13-15). Nevertheless He places obstacles in peoples' lives that draw forth their true character, whether it be good (2 Pet. 2:9) or evil (Rev. 3:10). Personally, I take this portion of Jesus' model prayer for the believer, "And do not lead us into **temptation**, but deliver us from evil," to be a request to God that He will not allow anything so difficult in our lives that we will be tempted to sin against Him.
