## C. The Good News about Jesus (adapted to counter the pagan religion of Evolution)

3. Two opposing assumptions
  - a. The God of the Bible
  - b. The Big Bang
4. God created you. You did not evolve. Gen. 1:1, 27
5. God will call each of us to account. Heb. 9:27
6. We all have sinned. Rom. 3:23
7. We earn death by our sin. Rom. 5:12; 6:23a; Rev. 20:14-15
8. God loves us; sent Jesus to die for our sins. Rom. 5:8
9. God raised Jesus from death on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day. 1 Cor. 15:3-5
10. If we place our faith in Jesus, we are forgiven. Acts 13:38-39
11. If we trust in Jesus, we are given eternal as a free gift. Rom. 6:23; John 3:16; John 20:30-31
