 - How can a Christian of humble circumstances glory in his high position? 1:9 He must realize (from Ephesians 1)
 - a. He has been blessed with incalculable spiritual blessings in Jesus. v. 3
 - b. He has been chosen before the foundation of the world to be holy and blameless. v. 4
 - c. He was predestined to be adopted as God's son! v. 5
 - d. He has been redeemed through Jesus' blood = forgiven! v. 7
 - e. He has a personal relationship with the most important human in the universe the Anointed King! vv. 9-10
 - f. He has an enormous inheritance coming! v. 11
 - g. He has been sealed with the Holy Spirit as a down payment on his inheritance! vv. 13-14
 - 2. How does the wealthy Christian glory in his status? 1:10-11
 - a. Answer: He is to glory in his humiliation!
 - b. How does he do that? He lives every day in light of his own mortality.
- B. Anticipate Your Reward. 1:12
 - 1. There are great blessings for the person who perseveres when facing trials & temptations.
 - 2. To "persevere" is to "remain under" the trial / temptation instead of cutting and running.

- 3. Don't try to wriggle out of your trial / temptation.
- 4. Ask God to help you endure it.
- 5. Approved: God is always looking to prove that we have endurance when we encounter trials / temptations.
- 6. God always wants us to succeed, not fail when we encounter trials / temptations.
- 7. God will reward believers who endure trials / temptations with the crown of life.
 - a. We are promised eternal life when we trust in Jesus (John 3:16; 3:36).
 - b. But we are rewarded with eternal life because we endure trials and temptations (James 1:12).
 - c. This is consistent with James' teaching that FAITH without WORKS is dead. (James 2:14, 26)
 - d. We call this "the Perseverance of the Saints."
 - e. It means true believers will persevere.
- 8. Eternal Life
 - a. We possess eternal life the moment we trust in Jesus (John 3:16; 3:36; 5:24).
 - b. But we do not receive ULTIMATE eternal life until we are present with God and Jesus in New Jerusalem (Revelation 21:1 22:5).
- 9. You show God you love Him by persevering under trials / temptations.
