“a certain man” (10:5)	“one like a son of man” (1:13)
“dressed in linen” (10:5)	“clothed in a robe reaching to the feet” (1:13)
“whose waist was girded with a belt of pure gold of Uphaz” (10:5)	“and girded across His chest with a golden sash” (1:13)
“His body was like beryl” (10:6)	
	“His head and His hair were white like wool, like snow” (1:14)
“his face had the appearance of lightning” (10:6)	“and His face was like the sun shining in its strength” (1:16)
“his eyes were like flaming torches” (10:6)	“and His eyes were like a flame of fire” (1:14)
“his arms and feet like the gleam of polished bronze” (10:6)	“His feet were like burnished bronze, when it has been made to glow in a furnace” (1:15)
“and the sound of his words like the sound of a tumult” (10:6)	“and His voice was like the sound of many waters” (1:15)

The Physical Effect of the Vision	
“the men who were with me did not see the vision; nevertheless a great dread fell on them, and they ran away to hide themselves” (10:7)	“When I saw Him I fell at His feet like a dead man.” (1:17)
“So I was left alone and saw this great vision; yet no strength was left in me, for my natural color turned to a deathly pallor, and I retained no strength. But I heard the sound of his words; and as soon as I heard the sound of his words, I fell into a deep sleep on my face, with my face to the ground.” (10:8-9)
