# Miscellaneous Facts about Angels

## A. Early References to Angels

- Angels were created by God. (Ezekiel 28:12-15). (This is a prophecy about the King of Tyre, but it goes beyond a mere human to describe Satan before he fell. This passage also records his fall into evil.)
- 2. Evidently, angels were present when God created the earth. (Job 38:4-7)

## B. Good and Bad Angels

- 1. Perhaps a third of the angels God created opted to yield to Satan's lies and joined him in rebellion against God (Rev. 12:3-4).
- 2. The angels who remained true to God were His chosen angels (1 Tim. 5:21).

## C. Angels Constitute God's Army

- When the king of Syria surrounded Elisha with horses and chariots, God opened his servant's eyes to see the mountain full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha. I believe these were angels (2 Kings 6:15-17).
- 2. "Praise Him, all His angels; Praise Him, all His hosts" (Psalm 148:2). The term "hosts" means "troops" or "soldiers."
- 3. The term "LORD of hosts" means, literally, "LORD of troops." The troops refer to God's mighty army of angels. (1 Sam. 1:3; 17:45; 2 Sam. 5:10; Psa. 24:10; Zech. 1:12)
- 4. Jesus could have asked for twelve legions of angels to protect Him (Matt. 26:47-53).

#### D. Angels had Important Tasks during the Life of Jesus

- 1. The angel Gabriel told the priest Zacharias his wife would bear the "Way-Preparer" for the Messiah (Luke 1:11-17).
- 2. The angel Gabriel predicted to Mary that she would be the mother of the Messiah (Luke 1:26-38).
- 3. An angel told Joseph he was to take Mary as his wife (Matt. 1:20).
- 4. Angels announced to petrified shepherds that the Messiah had been born in the city of Bethlehem (Luke 2:8-14)

- 5. An angel warned Joseph to flee with Mary and Jesus to Egypt to avoid the search of wicked King Herod (Matt. 2:13-15).
- 6. Angels strengthened Jesus after he had been fasting in the wilderness and was tempted by the devil (Mark 1:13).
- 7. An angel strengthened Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane (Luke 22:41-44).
- 8. A single angel rolled away the stone covering Jesus' tomb (Matt. 28:2). The petrified guards became comatose (Matt. 28:3-4).
- 9. Women saw an angel in the tomb of Jesus (Mark 16:5). He looked like a young man wearing a white robe.
- 10. Two angels wearing dazzling clothes terrified the women (Luke 24:4-5).
- 11. Mary Magdalene encountered two angels at Jesus' empty tomb (John 20:11-13).

#### E. Angels Will Have an Important Role at the Return of Jesus Christ

- An archangel will announce the <u>return of Christ for His Church</u> (1 Thess. 4:16-17)
- 2. At His <u>Second Coming</u>, Jesus will return to earth in the glory of His Father with the holy angels (Matt. 16:27; Mark 8:38; Luke 9:26).
- 3. At His <u>Second Coming</u>, Jesus will send forth his angels to gather His chosen ones ("elect") from the farthest end of heaven to the farthest end of earth (Mark 13:26-27).
- 4. At His <u>Second Coming</u>, the angels will weed out all evil people and cast them into the "furnace of fire" (Matt. 13:49-50).
- 5. Jesus will come in His glory and all the angels with Him, and He will sit upon His glorious throne (Matt. 25:31).
