- B1 The Departure of Israel 114:1
  - C1 {1} When Israel went forth from Egypt,
  - C2 The house of Jacob from a people of strange language,
- B2 The Destination of Israel 114:2
  - C1 {2} Judah became His sanctuary,
  - C2 Israel, His dominion.

#### A2 THE DESCRIPTION OF THE MIRACLES THROUGH METAPHOR 114:3-4

- B1 Of the Waters 114:3
  - C1 The Red Sea: {3} The sea looked and fled; 1
  - C2 The Jordan River: The Jordan turned back. <sup>2</sup>
- B2 Of the Heights 114:4
  - C1 The mountains: {4} The mountains skipped like rams, <sup>3</sup>
  - C2 The hills: The hills, like lambs.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Psalm 114:3 - sea: Ex. 14:21 – a reference to God's creating a path through the Red Sea through which the people of <u>Israel</u> could escape and the Egyptian army would be drowned.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Psalm 114:3 - Jordan: Josh. 3:13, 16 – a reference to God's miraculous damning of the Jordan at flood stage so <u>Israel</u> could safely cross to the western bank and begin its conquest of <u>Canaan</u>.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Psalm 114:4 - mountains, hills skipped: Evidently a reference to seismic activity elsewhere unrecorded in the Exodus events.

#### B1 Of the Waters 114:5

- C1 The Red Sea: {5} What ails you, O sea, that you flee?
- C2 The Jordan River: O Jordan, that you turn back?

- C1 The mountains: {6} O mountains, that you skip like rams?
- C2 The hills: O hills, like lambs?

## A4 THE WARNING OF THE EARTH THROUGH APOSTROPHE 114:7-8

- **B1** The Command to Tremble before God: {7} Tremble, O earth, before the Lord, Before the God of Jacob, 114:7
- **B2** The Reason to Tremble: God's ability to provide for His people water from the rock <sup>4</sup> 114:8
  - C1 {8} Who turned the rock into a pool of water,
  - C2 The flint into a fountain of water.
